This walk has been organised, and will be led, by MC Black from Detective Walks.

We shall follow in the footsteps of Sherlock Holmes from the Duke of York's Column to the site of Tyburn Tree (near Marble Arch).

The walk will start at 11:00 at the Duke of York's Column, which is at the lower end of Waterloo Place at the top of the steps leading down to The Mall. (Waterloo Place is a continuation of Regent Street going down hill from Piccadilly.) If you arrive in the area early, you can join us from 10:20 onwards at the Wetherspoon's pub, Lord Moon of the Mall (<http://tinyurl.com/3cmw6k>), at 16-18 Whitehall for tea, coffee and toilets. The pub is a short distance down Whitehall from Trafalgar Square on the right hand side. If you're really early, I understand that you can enjoy a £3 breakfast, but don't rely on that. We will have to leave the pub at 10:50 to walk back to Trafalgar Square and along The Mall to be at the Duke of York's Column at 11:00. (Follow the black line on the map to the arrow at the top of the steps.)

After the walk, we will take lunch at another Wetherspoon's pub, The Tyburn (<http://tinyurl.com/2kxke7>), at 18-20 Edgware Road.

Walkers are recommended to carry MC Black's cell phone number with them, so they can ring for help if they become separated from the main group.

The maximum number of people is 30 and the cost is £5.50.
